

Make this your best fundraiser ever with these low cost or no cost incentive ideas!

1. Prize drawing (for example a bike, an X-Box, or a scooter). Students get one ticket with their name on it for each item they sold for the drawing. If they sold 30 units, they get 30 chances to win the prize.
2. Prizes for the top individual sellers:
 - First Prize: TV Set
 - Second Prize: Boom Box
 - Third Prize: DVD Player
 - Fit these prizes to your budget
3. Pizza party for top selling class.
4. Popcorn and movie party for the top selling class.
5. Day off, early dismissal, or longer recess for the top selling class.
6. Free lunch for top sellers.
7. Hat day for students if they reach your sales goal.
8. Gum day if students reach your sales goal.
9. No uniform day for students if they reach your sales goal.
10. Free admission to the next school activity (Homecoming or prom).
11. Principal, teacher, or sponsor agrees to perform a stunt if sales goal is reached. (camp out on the school roof for a night, get a pie in the face, dress up like the school mascot, dye or cut your hair!)
12. A faculty vs. student tug-of-war over a mud puddle or swimming pool of shaving cream with the top selling class.
